SSSTFUW includes like-minded individuals in partnership with enabled individual and corporates for the betterment of the



UNFOLDING OF CANCER MIRACLE

With less than 180 days to go for the massive free health care project under Baba's Guidance, the freeof-cost Cancer Treatment Temple of Healing 'Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam' will be opened in Nov 2022! It is soon going to be a reality where a cancer patient can walk out fully cured and without having to visit a billing counter on his/her way out!



SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA BHARATI 50th MOTHER ESHWARAMMA DAY CELEBRATIONS

Marking the 50th Eswaramma Day on 6th May 2022, with the blessings of Bhagawan Baba, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare performed the Bhoomi Pooja for "SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA BHARATI", a residential School free of cost for Girls, that provides education free of cost upto 12th standard.

Mother Eswaramma, decades back in Puttaparthi, requested Baba to start a girls' institute, which went on to become the first Sathya Sai institute ever. It is indeed a great tribute to Mother Eswaramma, on her 50th Anniversary, that another girls' school is getting established. This temple of learning would come up at Sri Sai Palle (Chinakhandepalli) in Vizianagaram district near Thatipudi reservoir.





SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA PRAASADAM (DIVINE HOUSING PROJECT)

A humanitarian project filled with concern and love for the homeless was launched in November 2021. Through the project Sri Sathya Sai Divya Praasadam, 12 needy families will be recipients of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba's Divine Shelter in the form of newly built houses. Each house will have a hall, a bedroom and kitchen covering an area of around 65 - 75 sq. yards.



The 12 families, through the Divine Housing Project, will be able to lead respectable lives. The first Divine House had the Bhoomi Pooja done in Enumalapalli village near PuttaParthi. The construction for this is happening at top pace. Bhoomi Pooja for 2 more houses were done at Vishakhapatnam . 4 more identified families are in the pipeline with arrangements being worked upon.

The beneficiary families are from a needy background, and thus will now have a permanent roof of protection that will allow them to seek respectable livelihoods



DIVINE SUMMER CAMP

THE 4 DAYS BETWEEN 12TH AND 15TH OF MAY WERE FILLED WITH SMILES, CHEER AND ACTIVE LEARNING FOR ABOUT 190 CHILDREN BETWEEN 6TH AND 12TH CLASSES. THE DIVINE SUMMER CAMP ORGANIZED BY SRI SATHYA SAI TRUST FOR UNIVERSAL WELFARE HAD A LONG LIST OF ACTIVITIES THAT SETS A FOUNDATION FOR CHILDREN'S ALL ROUND DEVELOPMENT.





THE CHILDREN STARTED THE EARLY MORNING SESSIONS AT 5:00 AM WITH AUMKARAM AND SUPRABHATHAM FOLLOWED BY NAGARASANKEERTAN. FURTHER THEY UNDERWENT YOGA SESSIONS AND INSPIRING SESSIONS BY VARIOUS GURUS THAT HAD EXPERTS FROM YOGA CONSCIOUSNESS TRUST, OM SANTHI ORGANIZATION AND ART OF LIVING. THE EARLY MORNING SESSIONS CONCLUDED WITH BREAKFAST FOR ALL.





THE MORNING SESSIONS STARTED AT 10:00 AM AND HAD EXPERTS FROM THE FIELDS OF HEALTH AND VEDAS INSPIRE THE CHILDREN IN THE RESPECTIVE FIELDS. THE SESSIONS FOLLOWED WITH SNACKS AND MANGALA ARATHI.



THE EVENING SESSIONS WERE ELABORATE AND FILLED WITH GROUP ACTIVITIES AND GROUP DISCUSSIONS THAT FOLLOWED AFTER AUMKARAN AND BHAJANS. THE EVENINGS SAW GURUS FROM THE CHINMAYA MISSION AND THE CHINNA JEEYAR ORGANIZATION SPREAD THEIR KNOWLEDGE TO THE YOUNG ONES. DIVYA PRASADAM (DINNER) WAS PROVIDED TO ONE AND ALL.





DAY 4, 15TH MAY, WAS EXTRA SPECIAL FOR THE CHILDREN AS IT WAS FILLED WITH GAMES AND SPORTS ALL MORNING. WHILE BOYS ENJOYED PLAYING CRICKET AND TUG OF WAR, GIRLS PLAYED KHOKHO, TUG OF WAR, LEMON & SPOON AND QUICK REACTION GAMES. THE EVENING WAS SPARKLING WITH ACTIVITIES LIKE PADA POOJA TO PARENTS, SCIENCE EXPO, COOKING COMPETITION AND FINALLY THE CONVOCATION CERMONY FOR THE SUMMER CAMP.



OVERALL, THERE WERE 11 SESSIONS INVOLVING 10 GURUS. 190 CHILDREN BENEFITTED AND ABOUT 100 PARENTS WERE PRESENT. BAGS AND GIFTS WERE DISTRIBUTED THE CHILDREN AT THE END. THUS, THE SUMMER CAMP SUCCESSFULLY LAID THE SEEDS OF KNOWLEDGE, UNITY AND LOVE IN THE HEARTS OF SMALL CHILDREN THAT WILL GO ON TO BLOOM INTO GREAT CITIZENS OF THE NATION!





MEDICAL CAMPS FOLLOW-UP

Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare conducted a mega medical camp at Sri Sai Palle (Chinnakandepalli) near Thatipudi reservoir in Vizianagaram district on 24th April 2022. Over 200 people took benefit of this medical camp. The second free medical camp was held on 30th April at Pedagantyada in Visakhapatnam, where over 100 people were provided with consultation and medicines across 5 lines of specialties.



The ophthalmologist had advised spectacles for 18 people in the first camp and for 17 in the second camp. As a follow up, the team has ordered and distributed the 35 spectacles free of cost to the needy recipients.





SAI BUTTERMILK SEVA

With Bhagawan Baba's Blessings, the ongoing buttermilk seva across 2 centers in Pedagantyada in Visakhapatnam and Kothavalasa in Vizinagaram has been going on for 34 days to serve the needy in the hot summer. This will continue to happen daily till the summer heat reduces during mid-June. On the holy day of Vishu, April 15th, the trust started the buttermilk seva to quench the thirst of people during the hot summer.

While more than 8000 people on an average have been able to keep themselves cool in the scorching heat by benefiting from this buttermilk seva daily from these centers, there are beautiful instances that cool our hearts as well.



Called as Rays on Inspirations, there are selfless souls who, having been benefitted from this seva, participate in the seva in various ways voluntarily. While some join the team to serve more people, some contribute by preparing or procuring more buttermilk so that more and more people may get benefitted. These rays of inspirations are from various walks of life such as school children, homemakers, senior citizens etc. Different rays of inspirations are seen daily by the team, who encourage the team to serve with more zeal!



DIVYA PRASADA SEVA (NIGHT HUNGER ALLEVIATION)



Bhagawan With Baba's Blessings, Divya Prasada Seva was started for Madhukaris (needy) in September 2021, in order to help alleviate night hunger. While the Madhukaris are able to get food during the day thanks to some kind during hearted souls. the nights their access to dinner is restricted.

Called as competition-less seva, close to 120 Madhukaris now daily receive Divya Prasadam (dinner packets). While distributing dinner, the volunteers also spend quality time listening to the elders and the needy.

During these 250 days of daily seva, and for all days in the future, food is distributed not only for satiating their hunger, but is also used as a medium to exchange love with the Madhukaris.



SWAYAM PAKA SEVA

In order to serve the needy whose families live hand to mouth, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare, every month, reaches out to such needy families and supports them with monthly groceries.

Called Sai Swayampakam Seva, this helps the needy families, who are unable to make their ends meet, to cook food as per their convenience and quantity. This makes the needy independent of reaching out daily for food, and further plan a livelihood now that they are assured of food grains for a month. There are many instances where the needy families even use this over a couple of months.







Some of the 21 beneficiary families this month, across areas of Pedagantyada, Gajuwaka, Gopalapatnam and Kothavalasa near Visakhapatnam and Vizianagaram, are migrated labourers without ration cards and no access to government aid, those whose breadwinners are faced with medical problems and are bedridden, and those children's families that have single parents or have more children due to which they are not able to feed themselves.



ANDHRA KODAI TRIP MAY 17 - 21, 2022

A DIVINE RETREAT

Bhagawan Baba's Kodai Trips are the most awaited trips with His chosen ones. Swami decided to take his devotees on a wonderful trip to Araku Valley this summer.



The beautiful hill station of Araku valley near Visakhapatnam welcomed her Lord on this day. Bhagawan arrived at the Bungalow to a wonderful welcome by the devotees. The resort was surrounded only by green mountains, thereby making it an ideal destination for the Divine Retreat. 22

DAY 1: 17TH MAY 2022



Upon His Arrival on the first day, to the welcoming of devotees at the Bungalow, Bhagawan Baba immediately went to the newly built kitchen to perform the Mata Annapoorna Homam. The first spark of fire was lit in the kitchen after this homam dedicated to Mata Annapoorna. The morning session came to an end with lunch.



The evening session was held in a Satsang hall in the top floor in the Bungalow that had the most beautiful view of green mountains all around. Indeed, one would feel very grateful to be present amidst the Lord in the most natural of places. As Swami said, He Himself picked the people and enabled them to join for this Divine Retreat.





At about 5:00 PM, bhajans filled the hall with divine vibrations. A bharatanatyam dance session followed by a bouquet of blissful songs dedicated to Swami by devotees' children was enjoyed by one and all. The songs touched everyone's hearts setting us up for the next few days in the Divine Presence. Further, the trustees of 'Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare' talked about their journeys with Swami over the last few months.



Bhagawan Baba delivered His Divine Discourse. He told His heart is overflowing with Love seeing all His devotees gathered with Him. Further, He praised the children for their performance that was filled with dedication to please Swami. He told that God is happy most with those who put their talents to full use to please Him. Bhagawan Baba explains that Kodai Trip does not literally refer to Kodaikanal. Wherever He is, that is Kodai!



In His Discourse, Swami inspired the devotees to be non-faulty buckets in a stable and perfect position under the Divine Tap to be able to receive Divine Love and Grace in full! Further, He told that He will provide insights on Bhagawatham, during these days. The evening session ended with Divine Dinner bringing day 1 to a close.



Indeed, the day 1 provided an exciting start to the glorious and blissful trip with the Lord!

DAY 2: 18TH MAY 2022

A pleasant day one that included Bhagawan's message, for us to be unfaulty buckets positioned rightly to receive His Grace and Love from the Divine Tap, gave way to an interesting and colourful day 2. The day commenced with Aumkaram and Suprabhatham at 5:15AM, during the Brahma Muhurtham, getting the devotees to start the day with Divine chantings. As the sun rose and birds started chirping all around, Bhagawan performed Rudrabhishekam that had 3 cycles of Rudram chantings. As the hall was drenched in Divine vibrations, Swami lovingly asked all devotees to take turns to perform the Abhishekam to Lord Shiva. Breakfast followed bringing the early morning session to a close.





At 10:00AM, during the morning satsang, the devotees were in for a devotional treat. Bhagawan's loving 'Shabari sisters', two elderly sisters young and child-like at heart, offered a garland of Telugu Devotional songs on Bhagawan for Bhagawan. The entire hall was moved by the devotion filled in their voices.



Bhagawan delivered His Morning Discourse that praised the Shabari sisters for their bhaava. Bhagawan shared the secret of sustaining one's devotion for the Lord. He told that craving for the Lord alone can sustain the devotion, and for that one needs to keep contemplating on Swami. Bhagawan went on to provide a couple examples Srimad from of Bhagawatham. He compared Krishna to the white paper and Radha to the text or letters on it. Swami closed His Discourse by asking everyone to read the scriptures and to put the teachings into action.





The evening session took place in the open lawns outside the Bungalow. A traditional dance called Dimsa Dance was performed by locals in Araku Valley. Adorned in earthly tones of green and yellow, the performers impressed their Lord with fast and interesting formations, dancing to the beats of local instruments such as dappu, tudumu, mori etc. This was followed by a presentation by the 'Divine Technology' team who shared updates about the social media and website updates to the audience. A devotee from Chennai shared his experiences of Love that he received from Bhagawan. A sumptuous dinner followed bringing curtains to a devotion-filled day 2.





DAY 3: 19TH MAY 2022

The Divine Kodai Trip entered its third day - a day that was filled with joy rides, local outings, an enchanting Discourse and pot-breaking celebrations with the Lord.



The day, starting at 5:15 AM, swiftly moved through Aumkaram, Supbrabhatham and Nagara Sankeerthan. The most beautiful 'Pada Pooja' followed, which allowed everyone to have the Sparshan of the Divine Lord's Lotus Feet. Mahamrutyunjaya Homam followed next, raising the vibrations of the Bungalow and surroundings to new heights. Post breakfast, the devotees were in for a treat from the Lord! The Lord, the loving Father, provided everyone with money for them to spend in local markets to drive the local economy. The Lord is always interested in everyone's welfare, and thus He ensured that the local vendors etc. are able to have a good income during His Visit. The devotees travelled to the botanical gardens nearby, and had a joy ride in the toy train that excited the children. They next visited a chocolate museum to try out various varieties of chocolates. The devotees were next taken to a picturesque spot further up the hills. The children and elders alike 29 enjoyed playing in the waterfalls there. The team of devotees headed back to the bungalow for lunch.



The evening session started at dusk, in the open lawns. Beautiful pots were hung and children dressed as Krishna took great joy in breaking the pots much like Krishna and His company of friends back in Dwapara Yuga.



Bhagawan next took us all into the Satsang Hall in His Bungalow for a heart warming session. A devotee explained Gajendra Moksham in detail, following which Bhagawan delivered His Divine Discourse. He expressed His happiness to see everyone in the world praying for one another during the covid times. He likened the covid situation to Gajendra Moksham where people (like Gajendra) cried to the Lord to save them from corona (crocodile). He further went on to explain how devotees need to "Follow Me (Swami)" rather than "Follow Mind". Towards the end of the nectarine Discourse, He called for all to transform themselves through commitment to seva. As the day drew to a close, Swami and His devotees had dinner together like the Father and His children in a tightly knit loving family!

DAY 4: 20TH MAY 2022

As the Divine Kodai trip at Araku Valley sailed into the second half of the week, the devotees basked in the Bliss filled up in the Bungalow. Bhagawan, the Divine Magnet, decided to direct the 4th Day with a special homam for Lord Rama and a couple of Divine music programmes.



The early morning session started sharp at 5:15AM with Aumkaram and Suprabhatham followed by Nagarasankeerthan around Swami's Bungalow. This was shortly followed by Sri Rama Nama Taraka Homam that emphasized to all devotees the importance of Rama Nama - the Name that would ferry us across the ocean of samsara. With breakfast after the homam, the early morning session was complete allowing everyone to enjoy the Divine Bliss that emanated from the Homam.





The morning session started after a short break with some beautiful Bhajans and an offering of heart-touching songs in Telugu, Hindi and English by a group of devotees. Swami also had a guest from Hyderabad speak about His association with the Lord and His moments with Him in Hyderabad. Then, Bhagawan went on to deliver His Divine Discourse. Bhagawan congratulated the devotees for having chanted Lord Rama's Namam for 1,08,000 times since each line of "Sri Rama Rama Ramethi.." was equivalent to 1000 times chanting of the sweet Name of Lord Rama. Swami reminded us of the beautiful incident of how Guha (the ferryman at Sarayu river) abstained from charging a fare for Lord Rama's family across the river by citing the reason that Lord Rama too had the same occupation of ferrying, but that Lord Rama ferried devotees across samsara sagara while the Guha ferried across the Sarayu river. Bhagawan shared the secret of how pure love and surrender for Him can tie Swami in a devotee's heart.

He emphasized that the devotee would need to be steadfast at the Lord's Feet and would need to stick to unity of thought, word and deed. He ended His nectarine Discourse by reminding us that Kodai is like one's grandparents' house where the child is filled to brim with Love during its visit in the summer. The devotees indeed have been unable to contain the downpour of the Divine Love from Swami during these days at Kodai!





The evening session was all set to treat the devotees with musical extravaganza. The session started with the loving experiences of a dental surgeon and a PHD professional with their Lord. The PHD professional shared how Swami assured him of his PHD completion when he had lost all hope and was fearing the worst after his external valuation. The music programme was commenced by a devoted group of two seasoned singers, a keyboard player, a tabla player and a flutist, who formed performed with immense devotion for the Lord. Lords Ganesha, Shiva, Rama, Krishna and Shirdi Baba were propitiated and their glories were sung taking the entire audience to Bliss.





As the programme drew to a close, Swami went on to ask the flutist to offer a composition all by himself, which surprised and moved the flutist with eternal joy. The musical session was followed with a beautiful dinner session with the Lord in the open lawn. The buffet contained a rich variety of items. The evening session did not end here! Another musical treat was awaiting the devotees post dinner, at the lawns. The local tribe from the hills nearby dedicated bhajans for the Lord in their rustic but purehearted style accompanied by local instruments. The evening session drew to a close and the devotees realised they had just one more day with the Lord!



The Divine Days seemed to be flowing past swiftly and the devotees all seemed to pray that the Lord freeze these moments so that they can be with Him forever in those most blissful 34

DAY 5: 21ST MAY 2022



It was an emotional day for devotees as it was the last day of the Divine Andhra Kodai Trip. With Swami meticulously planning the entire trip, right from food menu to all programmes, a Special, Divine and Rare Treat was awaiting the devotees on the ultimate day!



Aumkaram and Suprabhatham started at 5:15AM followed by Nagarasankeerthan. Swami performed the Mangala Gowri Vratham for all 27 ladies. He tied the divine thread on the wrists of all signifying the Divine and Eternal Bond between the Lord and His devotees. Swami urged the devotees to hold on to the Divine Feet come what may, and that His Grace is in plenty for all. A couple of ladies shared their experiences. Following this, breakfast was served bringing the early morning session to a close.





Next on the itinerary was the Grama Seva where Swami went to the tribal village of Bheemunivalasa consisting of 141 villagers in 49 families. Each of the 141 villagers were provided with New Clothes (Sarees & Dhotis) and Divya Prasadam of Pulihora (tamarind rice) & Kesaribaath. Children were also provided with chocolates from the Divine Hands. The love of the villagers, ecstatic on the Lord's Arrival, pulled Swami to everyone's dwellings. New clothes were provided to the families. Post the Grama Seva, devotees returned to the Bungalow for lunch.





The evening session commenced. Swami decided to make it a memorable one that will remained etched in Divine History. He took all His devotees to the nearby forest like area surrounded by Sandalwood trees. The devotees entertained the Lord with Bhajan Antakshari. Following this, Swami spoke about Viswaroopa Darshan and revealed His Viswaroopa Darshan to all present, right at the time of the evening twilight! The Divya Chakshus of the devotees, who longed for the Lord's Darshan for ages, have indeed been blessed!





Swami returned with His devotees back to the Bungalow for the evening Satsang. Various devotees shared their Divine experiences during the Trip and were thankful to Swami for this most divine opportunity. Swami announced an Ashram in the Araku-Paderu highway stretch for tribals and others to make use of. The previous night's divine offering from the tribals seemed to have touched Swami, thereby making Him take the Sankalpa of providing them with an Ashram for their devotional activities. The Bhoomi Pooja of the Ashram, Swami announced, would be performed on the holy Krishnashtami day.



THE TRIP ENDS.. JOURNEY CONTINUES

The Divine and Blissful Trip, that would be forever etched in their memories, came to a close. As always, and especially with Swami, all these are temporary departures back to one's home, since Swami and His devotees are inseparable. The devotees prayed earnestly to Swami to quickly call all of them back to His Divine Proximity yet again!

On 30th May 2022, a team from Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare including Dr. Kalyan Sarvepalli (Secretary & Trustee) and Sri Subhash met Mr. GS Naveen Kumar – IAS special secretary to Medical and Health Department to discuss the latest updates of the upcoming free-of-cost cancer treatment hospital 'Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam'. The three discussed on various aspects on Cancer Care.

Mr. GS Naveen Kumar cited about the latest cancer status in the state. Dr. Kalyan and Sri Subhash discussed the various possibilities as to how the trust can work hand in hand and help alleviate cancer especially in needy & rural sections.







It was stressed that although there are state of art facilities to cure cancer, there is a need for Palliative care since doctors become helpless beyond a point when it comes to curing advanced cancer in some patients. The trust team handed over the brochure of the upcoming free-of-cost cancer hospital and updated him about the hospital's inauguration date.


