





Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare is very grateful to the honourable district collector of Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district Smt. Pamela Satpathy IAS, additional collector Sri Deepak Tiwari IAS, the Executive Director cum CEO of AIIMS Bibinagar Sri Vikas Bhatia, Deputy Director (Administration) Col. SP Anantarao for their unflinching support to help us conduct a mega medical camp at Raghunathpur in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district in Telangana.



The medical camp benefitted 190 needy people, of which 118 were females. The medical camp had 4 specialities such as General, Gynaecology, Dental, and Ophthalmology.





11 patients have been recommended for cataract surgeries, for which Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare will coordinate follow up . 26 were recommended to wear spectacles, and the trust will be ensuring to provide the needy patients free of cost spectacles as prescribed.

We also referred 2 others for further treatment at AIIMS - one girl child for pediatric care and another person for a surgery.



Most importantly, we had the solid support of doctors from the prestigious and dedicated teams from AIIMS Bibinagar and District Medical & Health Organization (DMHO) in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri. We are very grateful to the doctors from AIIMS, Dr Nabnita Patnaik, Additional Professor and HOD Department of OBG, Dr. Poojitha and Dr Santhoshi.



We also express our heartfelt gratitude to the doctors from DMHO Dr Rajender, Dr Bharath and their Pharmacist, along with the 5 ANM Staff. We also thank our doctors Dr Srinivas Murthy and Dr ChandraSekhar as well as the ophthalmologist specialist Dr. Anitha from Lions Club for their full-fledged support in the camp.

All these doctors, despite their busy schedule, supported the medical camp at short notice, and thereby have provided succour to 190 patients. We believe the medical camp would have made a difference to not only the patients' lives but also their families.

We are truly humbled by the entire team and once again thank everyone for their selfless service!



Sanatha means God is the one who is the real Natha for everyone and as such no one should feel that they are orphans just because they have no parents who gave them the birth, guardians or caretakers. Today in Gajuwaka area in Visakhapatnam, under the Sai Sanatha Seva area, 9 madhukaris, who could not afford to take care of themselves, were given a facelift by grooming them neatly.



They were given a neat bath using Dettol water, soaps and scrubs. Their hair and beard were trimmed, and new dresses were given to give them a neat look.

Divya prasadam along with a juice packet was served to them. This apart, they were provided with necessary skin ointments etc. to ensure their existing wounds are healed soon.

We thank the 10 volunteers for their selfless service in bringing smiles and gifting the Madhukaris with a new spirit of self spirit.

(NIGHT HUNGER ALLEVIATION)

It is unimaginable to have a peaceful day without access to good food. 150+ Madhukaris (needy beneficiaries) now have access to dinner meals everyday through Divya Prasada Seva.

More than 300 days have been completed since the inauguration of the Divya Prasada Seva, where the main intent is to ensure that no one goes to sleep hungry.

We thank all our patrons, well-wishers, donors and volunteers for their selfless support to this seva.





SWAYAM PAKA SEVA

In order to help needy families lead respectable lives and motivate them to look for improved livelihood, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare supports various needy families by serving them through 'Sai Swayampaka Seva'. Under this initiative, the trust supports them with monthly groceries, to enable them to cook quality food as per their convenience and desired quantity. This makes the needy families overcome the need to reach out everyday for food, and instead helps them plan a livelihood now that they are assured of food grains for a month. This month, 24 needy families across various areas in Visakhapatnam and Vizianagaram benefitted from the seva. The beneficiaries include a family whose breadwinner is no more and the children are physically challenged, some migrated labourers without ration cards and no access to government aid, those whose family elders have medical problems, needy single parents etc.

Apart from this, there were 9 more needy families in Siddipet in Telangana that benefitted from the Swayam Paka Seva.


